Snowmobile Tours

2 Hour Ride to Maroon Bells – Ride your snowmobile on scenic trails all the way to Maroon Lake at the base of the most photographed peaks in North America – the Maroon Bells. Enjoy a snack at the Lake then cruise over miles of groomed trails through Aspen groves and wide-open meadows.

TIME: 8:30 AM- 12:00 PM

COST: Cost: \$353 Single Sled/ \$283 per person double sled based on a minimum booking of 6 people.

TOUR INCLUDES: 2 hour ride, snack, transportation and gratuity.



What Should I Wear? Dress in warm layers finishing with a warm outer jacket, good quality ski or wool socks, warm hat, toasty gloves and fleece-lined boots. There will be equipment available for people who do not have warm enough clothing of their own. Please bring ski goggles or protective sunglasses.

Insurance: Snowmobiling insurance does not include collision damage for machines. Any damage that occurs to the snowmobiles will have to be paid for out of pocket. Individual credit cards must be posted as a damage deposit. A company credit card covering the entire group may also be used for the damage deposit. Each guest will be required to sign a lease/rental/liability waiver at the time of departure as is required by the US Forest Service.


Dog Sled Trip & Lunch

Be a part of the largest sled team in the Country! Experience a scenic and exciting dog sled trip through the surrounding wilderness of the Snowmass/Aspen area at Krabloonik, which means “big eyebrows” and is the Eskimo term for “white man.” This unique tour will include a two-hour, 12-mile sled ride controlled by an experienced musher and pulled by 11 Alaskan Sled Dogs. After your sled ride, you will enjoy a gourmet lunch of wild game foods and other choices in a rustic, homespun log building with views of Mt. Daly and Capitol Peak.

TIME: 8:00 AM- 1:00 PM

COST: \$400 per adult; \$255 per child based on two people per sled. Cost is based on a minimum of 4 people.

TOUR INCLUDES: 2 hour dog sled ride, lunch and gratuities for your musher and server.



What Should I Wear? We'll provide you with an Eskimo coat and boots. Don't forget a warm hat, and gloves.
What Should I Bring? You don't want to come without your camera!

Snowshoe Tours

Half Day Nature Tour: Just like a peaceful hike in the woods, except that we enjoy it in the snow! Join our guides today for a snowshoe nature tour. You will learn the fundamentals of snow shoeing as you visit a scenic nature trail to learn about the natural environment with a professional guide. Great for all levels and ages.

TIME: 9:00 AM- 12:00 PM

COST: \$114 per person (4+ people)/ \$385 group (1-3 people)

TOUR INCLUDES: 2 hour hike, equipment, snack, transportation and gratuity.

What should I Wear? Dress in layers based on the weather. These may include long underwear for your legs, zip neck top, synthetic sweater or vest, light to heavy ski socks, mittens or warm gloves, hat, lighter weight ski pants and wind shells or jacket. Exercise clothes with a light jacket and shell pants are also a good option. You will need hiking boots or a winter boot.

What should I bring? Sunglasses and goggles, sunscreen & camera if desired. We will provide a daypack.



Cross-Country Ski Tours

Half Day Technique Tour: Enjoy learning the basics of cross-country skiing with highly qualified ski instructors. Learn the graceful technique of the “kick and glide” on beautiful, groomed trails. With these newly acquired skills you will appreciate the beauty of winter as never before. Your tour includes ski equipment, lessons, snack and transportation.

TIME: 8:30 AM-12:00PM

COST: \$150 per person (4+people) /\$480 group (1-3 people).

TOUR INCLUDES: Your tour includes a 2 hour ski, snack, transportation and gratuity.

What Should I Wear? Dress in layers based on the weather. These may include long underwear for your legs, zip neck top, synthetic sweater or vest, light to heavy ski socks, mittens or warm gloves, hat, lighter weight ski pants and wind shells or jacket. Exercise clothes with a light jacket and shell pants are also a good option.

What Should I Bring? Sunglasses or goggles, sunscreen & camera if desired; daypack or fanny pack if available.



Sleigh Rides

TIME: 10:30-11:45

COST: Sold by sleigh: \$275 small (2-3 ppl) or med (4-6 ppl); \$375 large (7-8 ppl).

TOUR INCLUDES: A carriage ride from town to Northstar Preserve & sleigh ride for 30-40 min in preserve.
